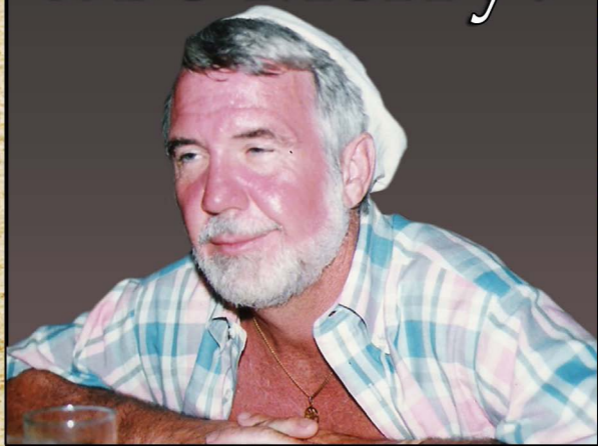
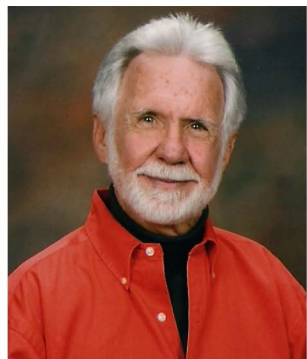

FROM A HOPELESS, SELFISH, DRUNKARD, TO A CHILD OF GOD...

I was born on a farm south of Cairo, Georgia. I grew up in a religious family. The only excuse for missing church was a trip to the hospital. Even though our family went to church every Sunday, Jesus Christ was not the center of our home. In 1957 I thought I got saved. I wrote my name in my Bible, but there was no heart change. There were no fruits of the Spirit.

I left for college in 1960. From the first weekend there and the 38 years following, my life was completely out of control with drinking and drugs. In 1970, my partner and I founded Jones & Rowell Real Estate Co. and within five years I had forty sales people working for me, two real estate offices, making all the money I needed; I thought I had arrived-Wrong!

Probably the lowest part of my life was in 1994 when I got alcohol poisoning and almost died. I could not quit drinking even then. God took it away two years later. Mark 4:19 will describe my life, "But the worries of this world, and the deceitfulness of wealth and the desires for other things will come in and choke the Word making it unfruitful."

In 1996, I went to a church in Snellville searching for a new girlfriend and instead of a girlfriend I found the love of Jesus Christ. What God did in my life at that point can best be described in Psalm 40:2,3. "He pulled me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire, and placed my feet on a rock, and

gave me a firm place to stand. He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God, so that many will hear and fear and put their trust in the Lord Jesus Christ." Jesus Christ became the Lord of my life and for the first time, I had a personal relationship with The Lord Jesus Christ. He gave me a new heart and He changed my desires.

Until 1996, I did not even know what a tract was. Now I have tracts in my billfold, my pocket, my car, my home, and in my hand. I got involved in outreach at my church. I have been involved with telephone ministry and mission trips from Virginia to Alaska to Romania. I have also been involved with the Georgia Baptist Disaster Relief going on disaster mission trips from Atlanta to Indonesia to Bam, Iran.

About five years ago I got involved in street ministry in places like Metro Atlanta, Phoenix, and Tampa. I open air preach, hand out tracts, and engage in one-to-one witnessing conversations.

I now use my real estate business to witness and share the gospel with tenants, contractors, and many others that I talk to on a daily basis. God has used me in all of these different ministries, but all of the glory goes to God. He used a broken sinner like me and allowed me His grace to bring others joy in Christ.

If God can do all He has done in me, a hopeless, selfish, drunkard from South Georgia, He can definitely help anyone who is looking for Him...

TRUST IN JESUS CHRIST TODAY! HERE IS WHAT YOU MUST DO...

1. Recognize that eternal life is a GIFT from GOD.

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of GOD is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

2. Admit that you are a sinner.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)

3. Realize that to receive this gift, you must repent (turn from your sin) and trust Jesus Christ as Lord.

"Repent and be converted that your sins may be blotted out." (Acts 3:19)

"I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish." (Luke 13:3)

4. Believe that Jesus Christ died for you, was buried, and rose from the dead.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

"That he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures." (1 Corinthians 15:4)

5. Through prayer, confess your need of Jesus and ask Him to become your personal Lord and Savior

"because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved...For 'everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'" (Romans 10:9,13)

The Bible tells us that God "is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9)

Our sin gives us a sense that there is a hole in our heart. We can try to fill it with things the world tells us: money, drugs, sex, love, power, work, and even attending church for the wrong reasons. However, only Jesus Christ can give us a right relationship with God (fill this hole).

Will you give your life to Christ today? If in your heart you desire a new life with Jesus as Lord, pray this prayer (or with your own words pray something like this):

"Lord Jesus, I am a sinner and I need to be saved from HELL. I know that I cannot save myself. I accept your death and resurrection as the payment for my sin. I repent of my sin and ask that you make me clean and pure today. I open the door of my heart and life to you and trust you, and receive You as my Lord and Savior. Thank you for hearing my prayer; please save me from Hell. Now Help me Jesus to live for You. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen."

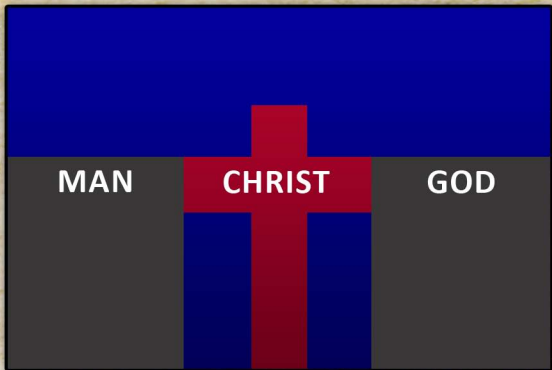
